**Eric Martin Presents his Selection of Australian Wines**

**White Wines**

**1. Tyrrell's Brookdale Semillon, 2013, (11%)**

Single Vineyard, Hunter Valley, NSW Lemon Freshness with a lovely rich lanolin texture. The floral nose leads into a palate that is seamlessly balanced between soft Semillon fruit characters and a clean, light finish.

**2. Beneficio Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc, 2016, (12%)**

Freshly cut lime and lemon with a distinct mineral edge. Concentrated, finely balanced citrus fruits with a superb finish.

**3. Penfolds Bin 311 Tumberumba Chardonnay, 2015, (13.5%)**

Pale straw with green hues. Citrus notes, with apple, pear, and floral undertones. Fresh nectarine with notes of fig and cashew on the finish.

**Red Wines**

**4. Benificio Winemakers McLaren Vale Grenache Shiraz, 2016, (14.5%)**

A juicy fruit-filled red that is super drinkable with barbequed anything, rich and rounded with classic sweet raspberry intensity.

**5. Pitchfork Margaret River, Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot, 2015, (14.5%)**

Clean, fresh and an inviting berry fruit nose. Aromas of vanilla ice-cream and strawberries. The palate is fresh and lively. Lingering fruit flavours carry through the palate which finishes with just a hint of red wine texture.

**6. Albacore Longfin Shiraz, 2015,(14.5%) McLaren Vale/Barossa Valley**

Beautifully textured, layered and lush fruit that fills the mouth. It will cellar well for at least a decade leaving you, at the end with a much more complex beast. Try it with rare beef.
