White Wines

Glup Chenin Blanc 12.5%

From a premium selected vineyard in the Valley of Marchigüe. A true expression terroir with a breathtaking intensity and richness. An expressive Chenin Blanc, from vineyards grown on volcanic soils and fermented using wild yeasts.

Longavi Sauvignon Blanc 12.5%

Crafted from premium selected vineyard parcels in the Valley of Leyda. A true expression of cool-climate terroir with a breathtaking intensity and richness.

Red Wines

Millaman Estate Reserve Cabernet and Malbec Blend 13%

An equal blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec from the Curicó Valley. Intense red with violet tints. A complex wine. At first, aromas of black fruits such as mulberry and blueberry are highlighted along with soft notes of spices and toast. A soft wine, ripe and sweet tannins, a balanced acidity and a long finish

Longavi Cabernet Sauvignon 14%

Crafted from a premium selected vineyard parcel in the Valley of Maule. A true expression of cool-climate terroir with a breathtaking intensity and richness. Deep and intense red, with dark fruit and blueberries. Great structure with ripe tannins and good acidity that bring freshness and a long finish.

Millaman Limited Reserve Carmenere 14%

From the Curico Valley. Intense red colour with purple tints. A complex wine. At first, sweet and spicy tones are emphasized and then opened to aromas of ripe red fruits, along with soft notes of white pepper, tobacco and cacao. Soft and ripe tannins on the palate. A tasty wine of balanced acidity, round with a long aftertaste.

Vultur Gryphus Red Blend 14.5%

From the Colchagua Valley, An elegant and complex wine of limited production. Predominantly Carmenere, with final blend percentages based on qualities of the year's vintage. Petit Verdot enhances Carmenere's elegance and Petite Sirah adds structure, colour and aging potential. Gryphus has an intense ruby red colour, showcasing the typical spicy touch of Carmenere, with cassis and liquorice aromas. On the palate, it's a structured and elegant wine, with lovely soft, rounded tannins and a complex finish.
