## **White and Rose Wines**

### **Sea Change Sauvignon Blanc on Vivino 2020 (12.5%)**

The first things we notice when we enjoy a glass of Sea Change Sauvignon Blanc are aromas of aromatic green citrus and grapefruit, set alongside beautiful balance and structure. Dry, fresh and full of summer zest. The initial flavours of fruit and blossom are layered with a subtle crispness that offers a sophisticated Sauvignon experience.

### **Sea Change Organic White /Chardonnay DO Valencia, Spain2019 (13%)**

This Chardonnay appears bright, like sunshine in the glass. A balanced combination of aromas and tastes creates a light, yet fruity wine. Nuances of white flowers on the nose and citrus fruits on the palette. It has a refreshing acidity, with a long lasting finish.

### **Provence Rose Grenache, Cinsault, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah 2020 (12.5%)**

We are thrilled to be working with the multi-award winning Château Pigoudet for our first Sea Change premium project. The wine itself is full of fresh zesty grapefruit, delicate white peach and tropical pineapple flavours. This sublime Provence rosé is perfectly balanced and guaranteed to impress.

## **Red Wines**

### **Negroamaro IGP Salento, Puglia, Italy 2020 (12%)**

Sea Change Negroamaro is ruby red in colour, an award winning wine that is rich and fruity; bursting with red fruit and sunshine, and we think it really ticks all the boxes, especially with its velvety mouthfeel. Medium bodied with soft tannins, the initial burst of bright fruit is followed by a smooth, lingering finish. A real crowd pleaser.

### **Sea Change Organic Red/Bobal, DO Valencia, Spain 2019 (13.5%)**

Hailing from the sun-soaked vineyards of Valencia, Sea Change's first organic red wine is from the Utiel Requena region of Spain which has been a winemaking area since the 7th century. Our organic red wine made from the Bobal grape balances intensity with the vibrant flavours of red and black fruits such as cherry, raspberry, and blackcurrant. With a deep ruby colour, this wine is full-bodied with high tannins and a beautiful long finish.

### **Sea Change Malbec IGP D'OC, Languedoc, France 2020 (13.5%)**

It is easy to understand the appeal of Malbec. A wonderful grape variety that produces wines that are both rustic in charm but also smooth, sophisticated and full of flavour. A grape variety that for years merely played a bit part in famous wine blends such as Bordeaux is now a true star in its own right. Our Sea Change Malbec is classic in style, full of rich black fruit and spice but also refined and elegant. Produced by the wonderful Chateau Canet in the heart of the Minervois, we feel it characterises everything that is loved about this amazing varietal.
