**Sea Change Sparkling, Northern Italy**

Produced from the Glera grape by a highly awarded artisan winery located in the heart of the Prosecco region of Northern Italy. A bright straw-gold colour with hints of elderflower, crisp apple and summer mint. Enjoy as an aperitif or paired with light dishes, seafood and salads.

**Sea Change Syrah Rosé 2020 Pays D'Oc IGP, Languedoc-Roussillon, France**

It's not a surprise to learn that the Languedoc produces incredible rosé wines. Made with the Syrah (aka Shiraz) grape variety, this Rosé is a beautiful, pale pink colour. Think fresh strawberries and watermelon, framed with a mouthwatering crispness that delivers a clean and refreshing experience.

**Sea Change Riesling 2020 Trocken, Pfalz, Germany**

This Riesling is a true icon of this famous German grape variety. Produced in the Pfalz wine region, located just south of Frankfurt and north of the Alsace. This is a dry wine bursting with ripe fruit and zingy acidity. It is wonderfully complex but exquisitely balanced through the expert wine making skills of Tina Pfaffmann and her team.

**Sea Change Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2021 Marlborough, New Zealand**

Situated in the northeast of New Zealand's South Island, this Sauvignon Blanc offers concentrated aromas of green fruit complimented on the palate by riper, tropical flavours such as passion fruit. Opulent and expressive; Complex layers of flavour, beautifully rich whilst balanced by a subtle minerality, and a clean, fresh lingering finish.

**Sea Change Negroamaro IGP Salento, Puglia, Italy 2020**

Sea Change Negroamaro is ruby red in colour, an award winning wine that is rich and fruity; bursting with red fruit and sunshine, and velvety mouthfeel. Medium bodied with soft tannins, the initial burst of bright fruit is followed by a smooth, lingering finish.

**Sea Change Merlot 2020 Pays D'Oc IGP, Languedoc-Roussillon, France**

The consistent climate of Languedoc helps indigenous grape varieties like Carignan flourish alongside more mainstream favorites such as Merlot. Full of dark fruit flavour whilst remaining soft and approachable. Crammed with flavours of delicious summer fruits and hints of green pepper on the nose. Subtle spice and soft tannins on the palate compliment the ripe berry flavours resulting in a delicious full bodied red wine.
