GinKing Rose

Ginking is all about refreshment, enjoyment and celebrating with a drink that is unique and truly delectable. Rose petals and exotic botanicals that reflect the history of England are blended with London Dry Gin and English rosé wine and then made to gently bubble. Enjoy it simply over ice in a gin balloon style glass. It's jolly good stuff!

Denbies Blanc de Noirs

This full-bodied wine has a fine mousse and a creamy, rich texture. Complex aromas and flavours of baked pear and rose petal are complemented by a hint of strawberry. The balance of fruit, minerals and crisp acidity lead to a round mouthfeel and lasting finish. Raspberry power and zing! Decanter Gold Medal Winner 2021

Litmus Element 20

Made solely from Chardonnay, fermented and aged in 2- to 5-year-old French oak barriques for 12 months and left on full lees prior to bottling. Complex, mature, elegant, and stylish there is a flintiness on the nose that carries through to a gracefully oaked full-bodied wine with a balancing acidity and a fine long, creamy, persistent finish that pairs well with seafood and vegetarian dishes.

Litmus White Pinot Noir

White Pinot is made from gently handled Pinot Noir which avoids the colour of the skins. The wine was matured in two to five year old French oak barriques for 14 months prior to bottling. Pale gold in colour with hints of peach, smoke, and honeysuckle on the nose. The palate is structured with a fullness, complexity, and roundness not often found in English white wines. Rich and silky in texture, and balanced with a steely backbone of acidity this complex wine, drinking well at the time of release, will continue to mature with grace in the years ahead.

Litmus Orange

Modern white wines are generally pressed from their skins prior to fermentation. Orange wine is a term given to white wines that have been fermented and aged on their skins. Pale gold in colour the wine displays hazelnut, fennel and marzipan characters on the nose. The palate has a touch of Vanilla spice, is incredibly generous and complex and boasts a long broad palate with a gripping astringency and smooth, long finish. Enjoy with oily meats and spicy dishes.

Litmus Red Pinot Noir

Made from 100% Pinot Noir. Cherry red with a vibrant translucency, the wine displays soft and smooth aromas of raspberry, sweet beetroot and clove characters. The palate is elegant and rich, under-pinned by an earthy smooth spiciness with a long pleasing finish. This superb English red wine pairs well with Lamb, Duck, and is equally good on it's own.
