1	Côtes du Rhône Villages Laudun Eléments Luna 2023	Great Wine Co	
A great example of the modern style of Rhône white wine – fresh and bright – from a village (Laudun) that is one to watch. Mostly Grenache Blanc and Clairette, with some Viognier and Roussanne.			
2	Côtes du Rhône Villages Valréas Clos Bellane "Comme un Saphir" 2021	The Wine Society	
Made from Roussanne grapes grown on chalk in the Valréas hills, this combines mineral tension and underlying richness. Organic.			
3	Tavel Domaine Maby Cuvée Prima Donna 2022	The Wine Society	
France's only appellation dedicated to rosé, which must be deep coloured. Intense, fruity and savoury – very food friendly and ageworthy. 65% Cinsault, 35% Grenache.			
4	Côtes du Rhône Clos Romane 2020	The Wine Society	
Mostly Grenache, with Syrah and a bit of Carignan, from old vines and low yields. Aged in a mixture of concrete tank and large, old oak, this is rich and intense, with a good "bite" of freshness.			
5	Côtes du Rhône Villages Plan de Dieu "Les Terres Saintes" Domaine Manarine 2020	The Wine Society	
Pure Grenache from a "village" that is known for richness and power. Soft tannins and a spicy finish. Organic.			
6	St Joseph J-L Chave "Offerus" 2020	The Wine Society	
From the northern Rhône, 100% Syrah from selected plots from across the St Joseph appellation. Balance between structure and intensity of perfumed fruit.
