



# Wines of Uruguay

#### Cerro del Toro Albariño Atlántico 2022 - Maldonado

Sappy, fresh and tangy, with notes of citrus and white pepper and a saline finish.

Bodegones del Sur Sauvignon Blanc Limited Edition 2020 - Juanico, Canelones Fermented in barrels, and aged in 20% new, 30% second used and 50% old ones, for 15 months.

Bizarra Extravaganza Orange wine 2020 50% Petit Manseng, 50% Gros Manseng Juanico, Canelones. Aged for a month on skins, a modern, well-judged orange wine with peach skins and orange zest flavours, a hint of tannin and an undertone of bruised apple.

### **Bodega Pablo Fallabrino Notos 2021**

Atlántida, Canelones 90% Nebbiolo, 10% Tannat Some floral, dried rose petals nuances, along with spice and lifted red berry fruits.

## Familia Deicas Extreme Vineyards Cerro del Guazuvira 2021

50% Merlot, 40% Tannat, 8% Petit Verdot, 2% Viognier from Lavalleja All grape varieties were harvested and fermented together.

Malted barley, fresh flowers, red fruits and notes of clay.

### **Bodega Pablo Fallabrino Austros Tannat 2015**

Atlántida, Canelones. 85% Tannat, 15 % Ruby Cabernet
Deep inky colour. Powerful and refined, great complexity, mature tannins and amazing youthfulness.
